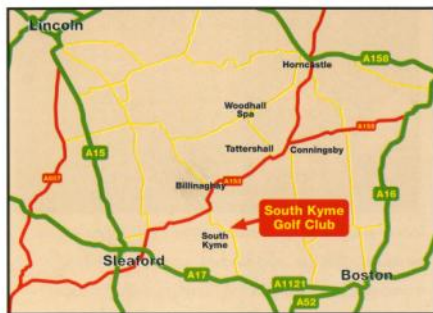
## Membership

## South Kyme Golf Club

South Kyme Golf Club is situated roughly mid-way between Sleaford, Boston and Woodhall Spa on the edge of the Lincolnshire fens. Our 18 hole course opened in 1990 and has undergone significant improvement to create 128 acres of tranquil woodland. The courses southern boundary runs for some 1200 yards alongside the Kyme Eau River. In 2005 the Environment Agency decided that the river banks needed strengthening. The clay for this project was sourced from the course, and in return a feature lake was constructed to affect mainly the 14th hole.

The course stretches to nearly 6600 yards from the white tees

which provides a challenge for all standard of golfer. The yellow tees at 6200 yards and the reds at 5400 make things a little easier going. The Par & SSS is 72 with 4 par 5's, 4 par 3's and 10 par 4's. We have a seven acre practice ground right next to the clubhouse, so the ideal place for the essential warm up before your round. The course is designed in two loops of 9 holes, which is ideal if you only have time for 9 holes

The course has been voted in the top 1000 courses in the British Isles and is amongst only 20 of the 56 from Lincolnshire who received this acclaim.

The clubhouse is converted 18th century barn, where under one roof the lounge, dining room, golf shop,



locker and changing rooms, showers and toilets are to be found. The Bar and Kitchen supplies everything from basic hot snacks to full meals, real ales to cocktails. Homely service prevails to produce a very warm and relaxed atmosphere.

The clubhouse also stages regular social events including quiz nights, themed dining nights and a Summer Ball. We also undertake bookings for Members Birthday Parties, Weddings and Christenings.

The golf shop is owned by the Members and carries stock and can source golf equipment from brands such as Titleist, Ping and Footjoy. All profits from shop sales go back into the running of the club.

The Club competes in the South Lincs Golf League and has two scratch teams. The Rabbits section provides the opportunity for new golfers to meet new friends, get cards signed to obtain a handicap and also play friendly matches against other clubs. The Ladies, Seniors and Juniors Sections are also a key part of the fabric of the club. These sections have their own Captains, Committees and run their own Matches and Competitions. All club sections have a vote on the Club Management Committee. Seniors Section play officially on a Tuesday and Thursday, the Ladies also play on Tuesdays. The Junior Section have the first tee booked for their games almost every Saturday morning at 09:00.

With the club being known for its friendly welcoming atmosphere with an absence of the cliques found at many old golfing establishments, it is perhaps no wonder that 2 key members have staff have been with the club since the early 1990's. Peter Chamberlain The Director of Golf undertakes the roles of Club Professional and Club Secretary he has been a member of The P.G.A. since 1986 and a member of the Golf Club Managers Association for 7 years. He does various styles of lessons from individual 1/2 hour lessons to occasional free coaching for beginners.

Peter Smith is another stalwart member of staff having been at the club from its formative days as green keeper. Back in those days you could see from one end of the course to the other, but now thanks to Peters dedication to the cause the course has dramatically improved. The addition of several 1000 trees in the past couple of years has added a new dimension.
